Adoption Event Volunteers: We participate in numerous events every year; often held in collaboration with local businesses such as Pet Food Express. We need volunteers to help handle animals, and interact with potential adopters at these events. Volunteers can be animal handlers, greeters or manage adoption paperwork at adoption events. Note: It is preferred that volunteers commit to 2-3 events in a year.

Foster Volunteer: All our animals are kept in foster homes. Help by temporarily welcoming a pet into your home until they are ready to be placed up for adoption. The rescue will provide the supplies and you will provide the loving home.

Fundraising Volunteer: Get creative in helping us raise money for the rescue. This is done by raising money or obtaining donations for NorCal Freedom for Paws independently then donating them to the rescue. Fundraising ideas for individuals/kids include: garage sales, lemonade/cookie stands, host an online auction, birthday giving, office/classroom giving, canned food or toy drives., scavenger hunts recruit local restaurants or businesses to sponsor the rescue.

Photography and Social Media Volunteer: We need help capturing pictures or videos that will capture the hearts of potential adopters. Our adopted animals are marketed on our website and social media and often the pictures or videos are what drive the interest for the prospective animals in need of adoption. Both amateur and professional photographers are welcome.

Shelter Volunteer: The rescue is run entirely by volunteers. Whether you have an hour a day or an hour a week, we would love your help. Assist in daily activities at the rescue including dog walking, dog grooming, organizing donations on shelves, socializing puppies/dogs and kittens/cats, cleaning/organization, putting together go bags, transporting of animals and or picking up donations and assisting and preparing for local adoption events.
